

# PRIVACY POLICY

Your privacy is very important to us. Accordingly, we have developed this policy in order for you to understand how we collect, use, communicate and make use of personal information. The following outlines our privacy policy.

When accessing the <u>www.mikiyaskinessentials.com</u> website, we will learn certain information about you during your visit.

Like other commercial websites, our website utilizes a standard technology called "cookies" (see explanation below) and server logs to collect information about how our site is used. Information gathered through cookies and server logs may include the date and time of visits, the pages viewed, time spent at our site, and the websites visited just before and just after our own, as well as your IP address.

### Use of Cookies

A cookie is a very small text document, which often includes an anonymous unique identifier. When you visit a website, that site's computer asks your computer for permission to store this file in a part of your hard drive specifically designated for cookies. Each website can send its own cookie to your browser if your browser's preferences allow it, but (to protect your privacy) your browser only permits a website to access the cookies it has already sent to you, not the cookies sent to you by other sites.

# IP Addresses

IP addresses are used by your computer every time you are connected to the Internet. Your IP address is a number that is used by computers on the network to identify your computer. IP addresses are automatically collected by our web server as part of demographic and profile data known as "traffic data" so that data (such as the Web pages you request) can be sent to you.

# Information Collection & Use

Effective date: February 5, 2024, Mikiya Skin Essentials ("us", "we", or "our") operates the http://www.mikiyaskinessentials.com website (the "Service"). This page informs you of our policies regarding the collection, use, and disclosure of personal data when you use our Service and the choices you have associated with that data. We use your data to provide and improve the Service. By using the Service, you agree to the collection and use of information in accordance with this policy.

We collect several different types of information for various purposes to provide and improve our Service to you.



#### Personal Data

While using our Service, we may ask you to provide us with certain personally identifiable information that can be used to contact or identify you ("Personal Data"). Personally identifiable information may include, but is not limited to:

- Cookies and Usage Data
- Email Address

#### **Usage Data**

We may also collect information on how the Service is accessed and used ("Usage Data"). This Usage Data may include information such as your computer's Internet Protocol address (e.g. IP address), browser type, browser version, the pages of our Service that you visit, the time and date of your visit, the time spent on those pages, unique device identifiers and other diagnostic data.

# **Tracking & Cookies Data**

We use cookies and similar tracking technologies to track the activity on our Service and hold certain information. Cookies are files with small amounts of data which may include an anonymous unique identifier. Cookies are sent to your browser from a website and stored on your device. Some Tracking technologies used are beacons, tags, and scripts to collect and track information and to improve and analyze our Service. You can instruct your browser to refuse all cookies or to indicate when a cookie is being sent. However, if you do not accept cookies, you may not be able to use some portions of our Service. Examples of Cookies we use:

- o **Session Cookies.** We use Session Cookies to operate our Service.
- o **Preference Cookies.** We use Preference Cookies to remember your preferences and various settings.
- o **Security Cookies.** We use Security Cookies for security purposes.
- DoubleClick DART cookie:
  - Google, as a third-party vendor, uses cookies to serve ads on your site.
  - Google's use of the DART cookie enables it to serve ads to your users based on their visit to your sites and other sites on the Internet.
  - Users may opt out of the use of the DART cookie by visiting the Google ad and content network privacy policy http://www.google.com/privacy\_ads.html

Once you leave our site's website or are redirected to a third-party website or application, you are no longer governed by this Privacy Policy or our website's Terms of Service.

Third party vendors, including Google, use cookies to serve ads based on a user's prior visits to your website or other websites.

Google's use of advertising cookies enables it and its partners to serve ads to your users based on their visit to your sites and/or other sites on the Internet. Users may opt out of personalized advertising by



visiting <u>Ads Settings</u>. (Alternatively, you can direct users to opt out of a third-party vendor's use of cookies for personalized advertising by visiting www.aboutads.info.)

We may also use third party advertisements to support our site. Some of these advertisers may use technology such as cookies and web beacons when they advertise on our site, which will also send these advertisers (such as Google through the Google AdSense program) information including your IP address, your ISP, the browser you used to visit our site, and in some cases, whether you have Flash installed. This is generally used for geotargeting purposes (example - showing Virginia real estate ads to someone in Virginia) or showing certain ads based on specific sites visited (such as showing home and gardening ads to someone who frequents home and garden sites).

You can choose to disable or selectively turn off our cookies or third-party cookies in your browser settings, or by managing preferences in your anti-virus/malware computer security. However, this can affect how you are able to interact with our site as well as other websites. This could include the inability to login to services or programs, such as logging into your account.

### Use Of Data

Mikiya Skin Essentials uses the collected data for various purposes:

To provide and maintain the Service

- o To notify you about changes to our Service
- o To allow you to participate in interactive features of our Service when you choose to do so
- o To provide customer care and support
- o To provide analysis or valuable information so that we can improve the Service
- o To monitor the usage of the Service
- o To detect, prevent and address technical issues

# Transfer Of Data

Your information, including Personal Data, may be transferred to — and maintained on — computers located outside of your state, province, country or other governmental jurisdiction where the data protection laws may differ than those from your jurisdiction.

If you are located outside United States and choose to provide information to us, please note that we transfer the data, including Personal Data, to the United States and process it there. Your consent to this Privacy Policy followed by your submission of such information represents your agreement to that transfer.

Mikiya Skin Essentials will take all steps reasonably necessary to ensure that your data is treated securely and in accordance with this Privacy Policy and that adequate controls are in place including the security of your data and other personal information.



# Disclosure Of Data (Legal Requirements)

Mikiya Skin Essentials may disclose your Personal Data in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to:

- o To comply with a legal obligation
- o To protect and defend the rights or property of Mikiya Skin Essentials
- o To prevent or investigate possible wrongdoing in connection with the Service
- o To protect the personal safety of Users of the Service or the Public
- To protect against legal liability

## Security Of Data

The security of your data is important to us, but remember that no method of transmission over the Internet, or method of electronic storage is 100% secure. While we strive to use commercially acceptable means to protect your Personal Data, we cannot guarantee its absolute security.

#### Service Providers

### **Analytics**

This data is shared with other Google services. Google may use the collected data to contextualize and personalize the ads of its own advertising network. You can opt-out of having made your activity on the Service available to Google Analytics by installing the Google Analytics opt-out browser add-on. The add-on prevents the Google Analytics JavaScript (ga.js, analytics.js, and dc.js) from sharing information with Google Analytics about visits activity.
